

- Users of our facilities do so at their own risk.
- 2m Social distancing rule is in effect.
- All users must wear a mask.
- WRCA will re-open in stages, starting immediately with:
 - 2019-2020 renters who can safely run their programs (non-contact programming)
 - Full reopening of the tennis/pickleball courts with COVID guidelines as posted
 - Full reopening of the Basketball Courts with COVID guidelines as posted
 - New long-term renters who can safely run their programs
 - Outdoor programs that meet the Alberta health guidelines and that do not need interior access
 - One time renters who have pre-paid their mandatory cleaning fees
- WRCA has implemented an enhanced cleaning regime, focused on disinfecting rather than cosmetics
- Users must sanitize hands upon entering the building and after contacting any shared surfaces
 - WRCA will make efforts to secure and provide hand sanitizer as a courtesy the responsibility to have hand sanitizer rests with the renter and the program organizer
- Renters must sign an indemnity agreement with the WRCA and keep records of all event attendees.
- One time entrants must record their Date of Entry, Full Legal Name, Phone Number, Email Address, Street Address, and purpose on our entry log (provided). This information may be visible to other users upon entry but will only be used for contact tracing should an issue arise.
- The North Hall, South Hall, and Herard Meeting Rooms all have designated entry and exit doors. Use the respective door for your direction of travel
- Rental groups should not intermix; common areas should be kept vacant
- Children must not be left unsupervised and any surfaces touched must be sanitized effectively by the parent/guardian.
- Do not congregate in high-traffic areas. Coat racks are disbursed through the building.
- If you have travelled within the last 14 days or have come in contact with a person who may have COVID-19, you must stay home and not enter the WRCA premises
- If you show signs or symptoms of COVID-19 (consult Alberta Health Services for a list of symptoms) you must not enter the WRCA premises
- If you contract COVID-19 within 14 days of visiting our facility you must notify us so we can confidentially contact trace with other groups

Failure to follow guidelines will constitute an immediate cancellation of the rental agreement and all patrons must vacate immediately.
