Dear Parents/Guardians of City of Calgary, Calgary Neighbourhoods Program Participants,

Subject: Coronavirus (COVID-19)

Keeping our programs safe is a core value at The City – it's part of who we are as an organization.

Safety at The City of Calgary is essential to the work that we do. Keeping your child safe while participating in our programs is of the utmost importance to our staff. We have several measures in place to ensure that we are following safety guidelines in our programs. We are taking a proactive approach to reduce the opportunities for transmission within our programs.

Due to the recent concerns about the COVID-19 virus, we are adding some additional safety measures.

If your child/youth is not feeling well, we ask that they stay home until they feel better. Home is the most comfortable place for a child/youth who is not well. If your child/youth becomes unwell during the program, they will be supported to rest in a quiet space within monitoring distance from a Recreation Leader while waiting to be picked up to be taken home to recover. We recommend contacting HealthLink 811 if your child is experiencing fever, cough, difficulty breathing or other flu like symptoms.

In order for us to reduce opportunities for transmission, we will be taking the following measures:

1. Provide participants and staff access to wash their hands with soap and water or sanitize before entering the program.
2. Ask all participants and staff to cover their mouth and nose while coughing or sneezing with a tissue or flexed elbow and disposing of used tissues in a plastic bag and immediately putting into the trash container. This must immediately be followed by proper hand washing.
3. Require all participants and staff to carefully wash their hands before distributing snacks. Prior to and immediately following snack, program leaders will wipe down the snack area with disinfecting wipes.
4. Enforce a “**no sharing**” policy where participants will be reminded not to share anything, including food, drinks, water bottles, etc.
5. Modify all **games** where possible that involve direct person to person contact. Elbows, knees, ankles, etc. should be substituted for hands where possible.
6. Cleaning and disinfecting high touch areas.
7. Encouraging physical/social distancing while participating in program activities.
8. Supporting staff to wear face coverings when within two metres distance or when mask bylaw orders are in place.

The City of Calgary is committed to the safety of our participants and staff. We will continue to actively monitor the situation and work closely with Alberta Health Services around additional safety responses to COVID-19.

Subject: City of Calgary Bylaw #65M2021

Proof of vaccination requirements in city-operated programs

The Province's Restrictions Exemption Program and the City of Calgary Bylaw #65M2021 apply to City-operated program. Children 0-11 years of age will NOT be required to show proof of vaccination, or a negative COVID-19 test to access City-operated recreation facilities.

What you need to show

Any person aged 12 years and older must show identification and one of the following:

Accepted form of personal Identification in City programming

- Birth certificate issued by a government of a province of Canada
- Citizenship card
- Driver's license issued by a government of a province of Canada
- Government (Alberta or other) issued identification card, including health card
- Certificate of Indian status
- Inuit Status card
- Passport attesting to citizenship or other national status, issued by a government of any jurisdiction
- Permanent Resident Card
- Student ID (For youth under 18 years old)
- Any other form of identification recognized by the Chief Medical Officer of Health

Proof of vaccination

Your proof of vaccination must display the name, type of vaccine and the date it was received.

This can be a paper COVID-19 vaccination record or shown on an electronic device from:

- Alberta Health Services
- A First Nation
- Your pharmacy
- Your physician
- Another province or territory
- Canadian armed forces

You can [print your own card online](#) or get one printed for free at any [Registry Agent](#).

Proof of negative test result

You can show a COVID-19 negative test result. Tests must be:

- Provided as an original or printed copy (photos are not sufficient)
- A person has taken within the last 72 hours



- Clearly outlines the laboratory that completed the test, the type of test, time of sample collection and a clear indication of a negative result
- Is not sourced from the Alberta Health Services public COVID-19 testing system

Test results must show the type of test, time of sample collection, clear indication of a negative result, and laboratory that completed the test.

Tests must not be from Alberta Health Services or Alberta Precision Laboratories.

Medical Exemption

Medical exemption from vaccine letter

You must show an original signed letter from a physician or nurse practitioner that includes:

- Physician's or nurse practitioner's complete information, including their name, phone number, contact information, professional registration number and signature
- A statement that there is a medical reason for not being fully vaccinated against COVID-19
- The duration that the exemption is valid

The City of Calgary is committed to the safety of our participants and staff. We will continue to actively monitor the situation and work closely with Alberta Health Services around additional safety responses to COVID-19.
